The Competitive CDBG

- Federal funds that are given to the state, which are then allocated to Georgia communities through a competitive process.
- Grant money intended for low-to-moderate income neighborhoods to help pay for infrastructure improvements.
- The grant will pay for water, sewer, and flooding issues.

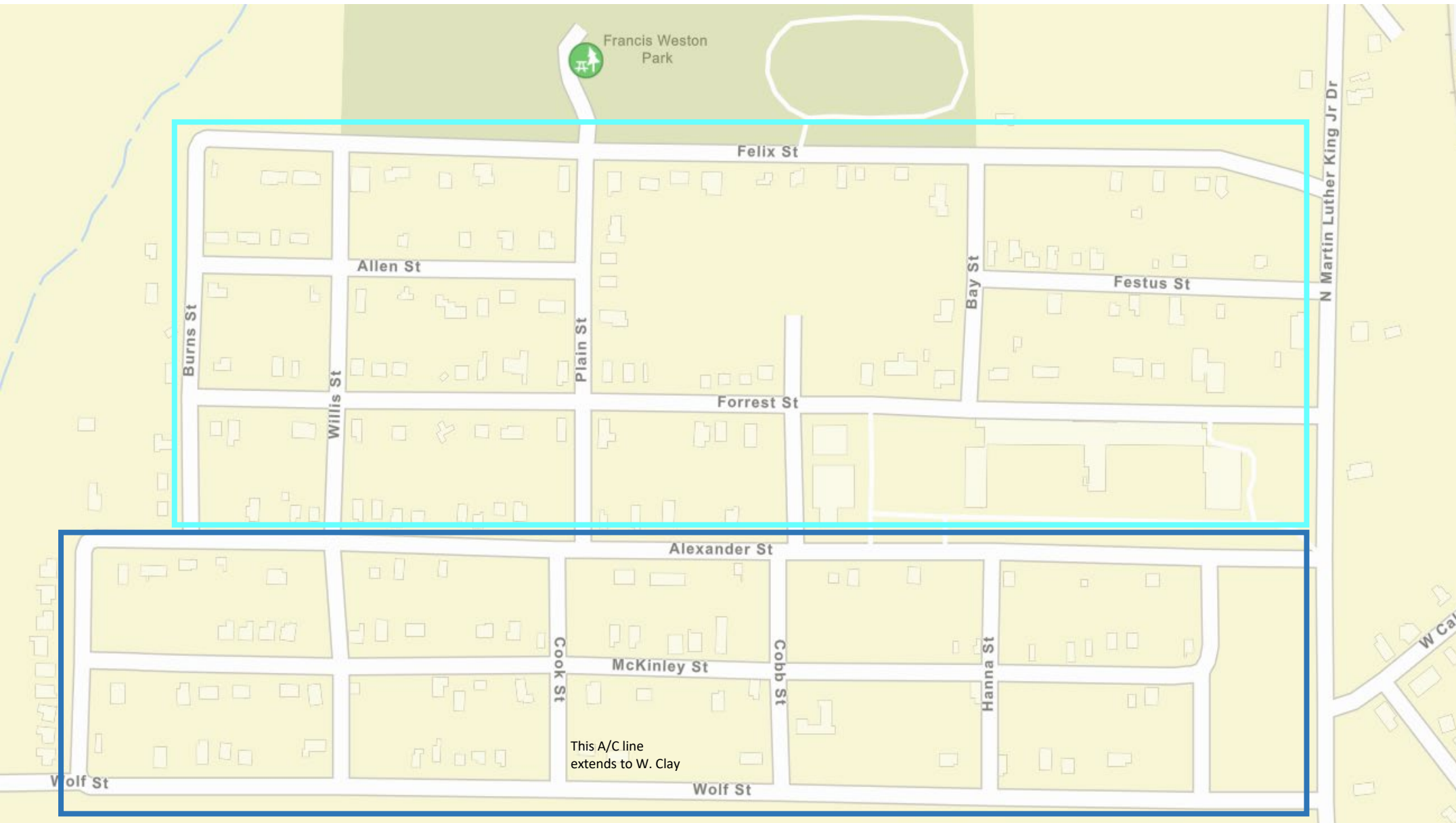
Proposed Improvements for the Dewey City Neighborhood

- Repair and replace aging water pipes
- Repair and replace aging sewer pipes
- Address drainage and flooding concerns
- Resurface neighborhood streets

- Funding
 - Grant: Up to \$750,000
 - Local Match: Water/Sewer Capital and 2018 SPLOST

2021 CDBG: PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AREAS

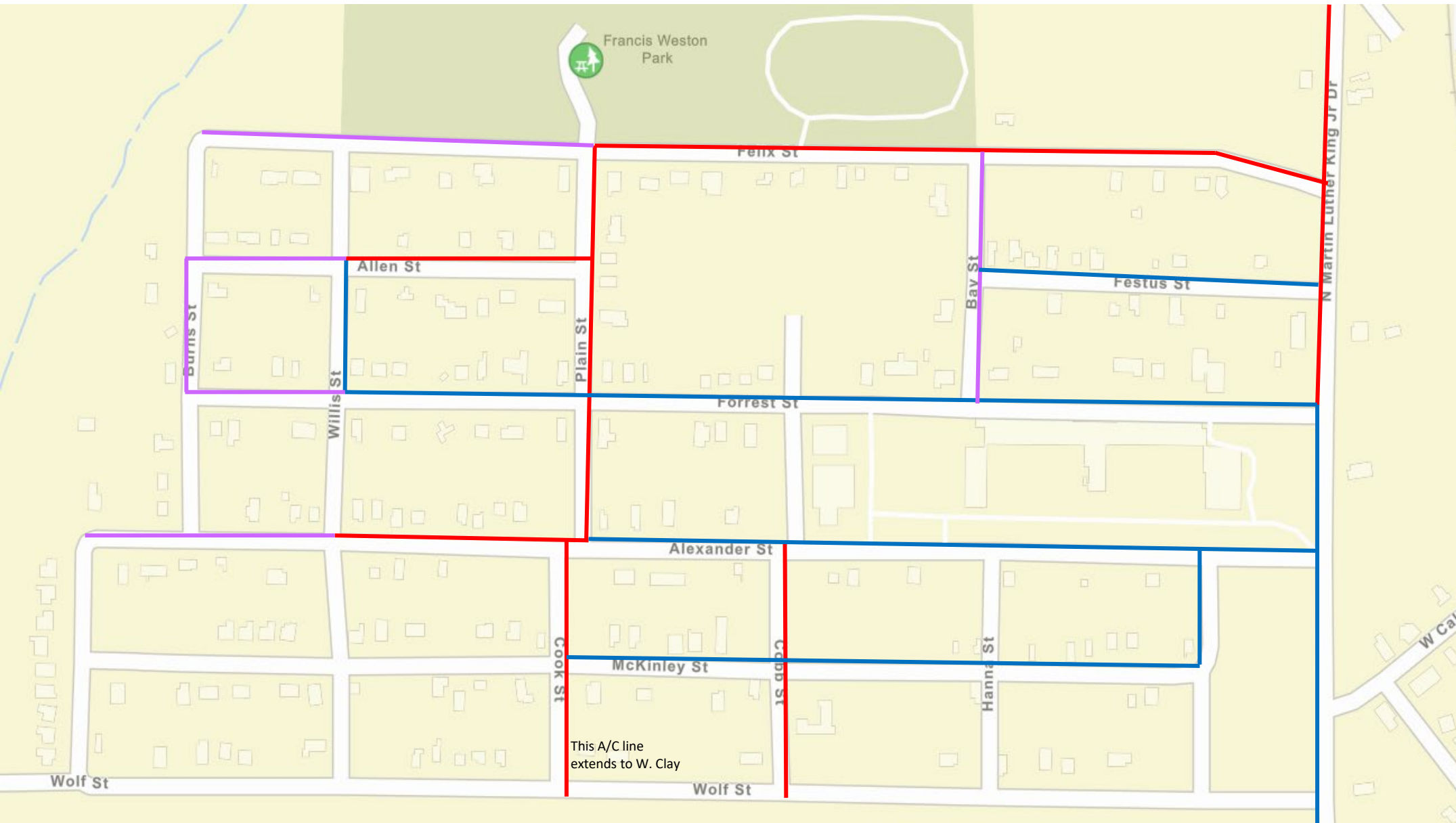

Dewey City Neighborhood Area



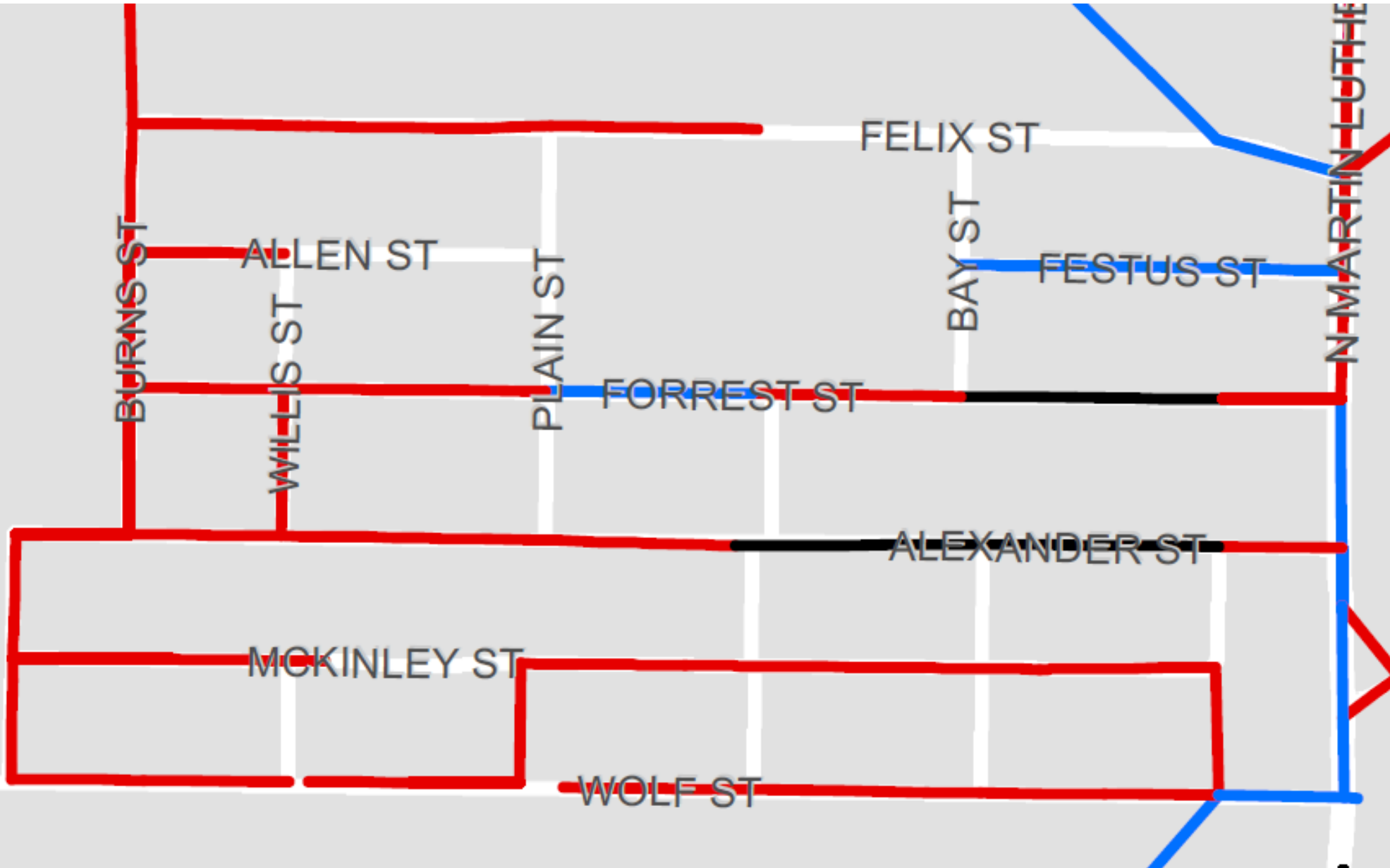
