The Competitive CDBG

- Federal funds that are given to the state, which are then allocated to Georgia communities through a competitive process.
- Grant money intended for low-to-moderate income neighborhoods to help pay for infrastructure improvements.
- The grant will pay for water, sewer, and flooding issues as well as demolition of unfit houses.




Proposed Improvements for the Dewey City Neighborhood

- Repair and replace aging water pipes
- Repair and replace <u>aging sewer pipes</u>
- Address drainage and flooding concerns
- Resurface neighborhood streets
- Demolition of unfit houses
- Funding
 - Grant: Up to \$1,250,000
 - Local Match: Water/Sewer Capital and 2018 SPLOST




2022 CDBG: PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT AREA Dewey City Neighborhood Area






2022 CDBG: PRELIMINARY WATER IMPROVEMENT Dewey City Neighborhood Area






2022 CDBG: PRELIMINARY SEWER IMPROVEMENT Dewey City Neighborhood Area
