The Council of the City of Thomasville met in a called session with Mayor Greg Hobbs presiding and the following Councilmembers present: Mayor Pro Tem Terry Scott, Councilmembers Jay Flowers, David Hufstetler, and Todd Mobley. Also present were the City Attorney, Tim Sanders; City Clerk, Felicia Brannen; S. Renee Narloch and Elliot Pervinich of S. Renee Narloch & Associates. The called meeting was held in the City Manager's Conference Room at 111 Victoria Place, Thomasville, Georgia. It was noted there were no citizens in attendance at this meeting.

Mayor Hobbs called the meeting to order at 1:30 PM. He reported this meeting was called for the purpose of discussion and deliberation of City Manager position with S. Renee Narloch & Associates.

On motion of Mayor Pro Tem Scott, and seconded by Councilmember Flowers, Council voted unanimously to close the public meeting and enter into Executive Session pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 50-14-3(b)(2) to discuss or deliberate upon the appointment, employment, compensation, hiring, disciplinary action or dismissal, or periodic evaluation or rating of a city official or employee.

On motion of Mayor Pro Tem Scott, and seconded by Councilmember Mobley, Council voted unanimously to reopen the public meeting at 2:55 PM.

It was noted there were six-eight potential candidates for the position of Thomasville City Manager. Ms. Narloch reported having previously coordinated with Executive Assistant Vicky Bryson the dates of September 18-19, 2018 for interview sessions. Ms. Narloch agreed to contact the candidates Council discussed for interview session availability on those dates.

Council discussed potential appointment timelines, legalities of public notification and potential creation of a selection committee to assist with the final selection process. City Attorney Sanders informed Council that pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 50-18-72 (a)(11) Council is required to make available to the public fourteen calendar days prior to the meeting at which final action or vote is to be taken on the position of executive head of an agency all documents concerning the final three persons under consideration whom the they have determined to be the best qualified for the position of City Manager.

Having no further discussion, the called meeting of the City of Thomasville City Council was adjourned at 3:05 PM.
