



Blueprint: 2028 Code Audit in Review

Earlier this month, the City of Thomasville hosted a series of public meetings to gather input from local citizens, businesses, and organizations on some of the challenges our community faces with our existing Land Development Codes. The goal was to work towards creating a unified ordinance that will be straightforward and easily understood. The public meetings were held after a code audit was performed, and the City of Thomasville staff recognized the need to update several Land Development Codes.

After compiling input from the community and staff, a list of items in our current code needing revisions, changes, and updates has been developed. Over the next several months, the first draft of updated codes will be established. Once completed, the City of Thomasville will hold a 2-3 day Code Workshop where the draft code will be on display for the public to view and suggest changes. The workshop, tentatively scheduled for May, will also include a public presentation and open house along with technical meetings with stakeholders.

TPD Warns of Utility Payment Scam

The Thomasville Police Department recently issued a warning after receiving several reports of City of Thomasville Utilities customers receiving fraudulent calls. These calls demanded immediate payment by telephone for utility services. As a reminder, City of Thomasville customers will never be called and asked to provide immediate payment by telephone, so instances such as this should be a red flag. Customers should also use caution if a call is received that requests payment to be made via wire transfers or with gift cards.

Please protect yourself and be cautious when releasing any financial information to callers claiming to be from the City of Thomasville. The City of Thomasville has received a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) in the amount of \$750,000 from the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA). Thomasville is utilizing this grant for water and wastewater improvements in the Fletcherville community.

Construction began on December 11th and is continuing in the project area. As a result, you may have noticed several detours in the Fletcherville neighborhood. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause, but these minor disruptions have been necessary to accommodate important work on our wastewater system infrastructure.
