
Welcome Chief Letteney

John Letteney was sworn in on Monday, January 11th as the new Chief of the Thomasville Police Department during a ceremony held at Thomasville Fire Rescue Station 1. Judge Mark Mitchell officiated the ceremony of Letteney as TPD's sixth Chief of Police. Letteney was joined by Debbie, his wife of 38 years, who held the Police Bible as he recited the Oath of Office.

During his remarks, Letteney spoke about the importance of enhancing relationships with TPD's public safety partners and with the community. He stated that this step is important because law enforcement exists to serve the public by being an integral part of the community and by forging relationships to enhance its ability to solve problems. Throughout his 39 years in law enforcement his guiding philosophy has been to be the police officer he would want to serve his family in a crisis.

Enhancements Continue at Weston Park

Have you seen the work happening at Francis Weston Park? Construction is now underway for many exciting enhancements to Weston Park. The Weston Park Vision Plan was adopted in 2018 after extensive public input was received during a three-day public visioning and planning event held in 2017. The plan serves as the guiding document for projects and improvements within Weston Park. The first phase of improvements was completed in late 2017.

Current improvements underway at this popular park will include:

- A lighted 1/3 mile walking trail
- Resurfacing of the basketball courts
- New landscaping including new trees and shrubs
- Improved playground
- Renovated picnic area
- New parking lot
- Restroom improvements

We are looking forward to the completion of this phase in mid to late April.


